



SCRIP-ture NOTES FOR THE SUMMER

There will be NO scrip office hours anywhere the week of May 31-June 4 to allow for closure of the fiscal year.

The new fiscal year begins June 7 at which time "on demand" will be available Monday-Friday 8-5pm at the Administration Office, which is located in the Little Flower building at 120 South 34th Street.

Each family with a student K-12 has a fundraising requirement of \$250 for the 2010/2011 school year. A family may opt-out of the program by simply paying the \$250. Remember the fundraising amount is accumulated based on the discount % you will see on the order form, not on your purchased amount.

The only Scrip drop boxes available during the summer are:

- ST. PIUS PARISH CENTER: Through the door; the black box is located on the left wall. Scrip orders may be dropped off here, but you may NOT pick up from here. Your order will be available for pick up at the Administration Office, or you can make other arrangements with Darcie.
- ST. BERNARD'S PARISH: The black box is located in the back of the church.
- ADMINISTRATION OFFICE: The box is located on the 2nd floor door.

Because of the ordering schedule, your orders need to be dropped off by Mondays at 3pm to guarantee delivery of your cards by Thursday of the same week.

We would encourage you to get in the habit of dropping off your next week's order when you pick up your current order on Thursdays. Then you only have to make one trip a week.

Don't forget you may also do your ordering through shopwithscrip.com. You will find the school code and information on how to set up your account on the school website. Doing your ordering with shopwithscrip and prestopay is very convenient and easy. Prestopay costs only 39cents per time you use it.
